It's hard to ignore the fence around the playground. The area has been closed following the death of three mature remnant Eucalyptus melliodora and severe decline in another three adjacent trees. The council has engaged expert advice on control measures for managing the problem both here and throughout the wider Monash municipality. Council update with Andrew Bailey

Fern Gully project: This year the Council will embark on a 3 year project to upgrade the fern gully. Works will involve contouring to control surface water flow through the open area at the end of Swayfield Road as well as works in the stream bed and gully sides.

Organisation changes: Due to a number of staff changes the opportunity to revise the operation of the bush crew has been taken. Under revised arrangements the Northern and Southern sections of the reserve are combined. Additionally bush crew from across Monash will periodically participate in working parties in reserves other than their primary locations.

Dogs on lead/ off lead signage: We have been advised that revised signage indicating on lead/off lead status should be installed by the end of March.
