## **Visitor to Damper Creek**

Maryann Hawthorn spotted a Golden Whistler in Damper Creek the other day.

From time to time Damper Creek hosts rare (or at least uncommon) visitors. Is this the first time the Golden Whistler has been sighted in Damper Creek? My search of the internet has revealed that this species ranges along the eastern and southern parts of Australia and the islands to Australia's north. The species is highly variable and the female does not share the bight plumage of the male bird.

It is not listed as endangered though it may escape detection due to its small size.
