# Update on VPO – Panel Victoria Report dated 13 August 2013

At the meeting of the Friends of Damper Creek Reserve Inc. on Wednesday 28 August 2013, it was unanimously agreed to strongly support the conclusions and recommendations of the Panel Victoria report dated 13 August 2013, which will be voted on at the next meeting of the Monash City Council on **Tuesday 24 September 2013.**

The Friends have written to all the Councillors, CEO and the Mayor to bring to their attention the following text which is contained within the Panel Report, Page 49, dot point 9.

# **Consolidated Recommendations**

Based on the reasons set out in this Report, the Panel recommends:

- 1. Amendment C115 to the Monash Planning Scheme should be abandoned.
- 2. The Vegetation Protection Overlay Schedule 1 Tree Protection Area (VPO1) should be retained.
- 3. That Council should undertake additional work to better determine vegetation values (with expert and community input) and to review planning policies as part of an integrated approach towards vegetation protection and management under the Monash Planning Scheme.

All Friends are encouraged to attend the Monash City Council meeting on Tuesday 24 September 2013 from 7.30pm at the Civic Centre Monash Council Citv Springvale Road Glen Waverley as the Council still has three options at this meeting (1) to abandon the Amendment (2) to proceed with the Amendment (which would require final approval by the State Planning Minister) or (3) to investigate possible changes to the Amendment, - the Friends have voted that the contents of the Panel Victoria report is accepted at this meeting.
